## Application for Student Assistance

### PROOF OF RESIDENCY

If you are applying for the first time for Student Assistance you will need to provide **PROOF OF RESIDENCY**. The supporting documentation must show your residential address; not a postal box address.

**Supporting documentation that will be accepted is as follows:**

- \* a current NT drivers licence;
- \* a statutory declaration stating that you are a resident of that community; signed by a local police officer, council representative or other local community organisation (*please note: the witness needs to ensure their contact details are noted on the statutory declaration*)
- \* a utilities account eg. telephone or electricity
- \* a residential rate notice
- \* a letter from the Electoral Commission stating your voting ward; or
- \* correspondence from a financial institution.

#### **NOTE**

If you were approved for Student Assistance for 2007, you do not need to provide the above information unless your details have changed
