NTHS provides comprehensive diagnostic hearing assessments from birth to adulthood with referral accepted from any source including self-referrals. Further complex audiological assessment (eg, electrophysiological testing, or central auditory processing assessments) can be conducted on request from medical and educational staff. NTHS inter-refer with other hearing agencies as appropriate and provide reports for all clients to the referral source and with consent to any other agency.

NTHS also provide a visiting service to the following Indigenous communities to perform diagnostic assessments on school aged children and adults and provide input into appropriate management of any identified hearing loss (referral for medical review and/or amplification, classroom strategies):

NTHS also can provide ear health education and information to the public and medical/nursing staff as requested.

AH provides comprehensive hearing services including hearing assessment, fitting of hearing aids and follow-up to most pensioners, war veterans, war widows and dependents of the above; members of the Australian Defence Forces and those referred as parts of the Commonwealth Rehabilitation Service Australia (CRS) program.

AH provide amplification and ongoing support for children (those under 21 years) with a hearing loss and their families.

AH also provide a visiting service to the following Central Australian Indigenous communities to develop and deliver hearing services specific to their needs
